



Welcome to the Pioneer Skatepark.

Please read the following and ensure you understand it.

Ask a member of staff if you are unsure.

- The participant acknowledges that participation in skateboarding, in-line skating, Parkour, scooter riding and other activities known as dangerous entails known and unknown risks that could result in physical injury or potentially death, damage to property or to third parties.
- Risks include, but are not limited to, collision with other participants, walls or other fixed objects, falling, equipment failure, broken bones, sprains, head and back injuries, abrasions and bruises.
- Due to the hazardous nature of these extreme sports, you participate at your own risk, liability for personal injury or death cannot be taken by the Trustees or staff at The Pioneer Club and you agree to waive liability for any injuries, ailments or other damage to you or your property whilst using The Pioneer Club Skatepark.
- Helmets must be worn at all times by under 16s. Over 16s are recommended to wear a helmet but if they choose not to do so it is at their own risk.
- Skate within your own limits and do not take unnecessary risks. Skate only the length of the park. Do not skate across the park or across other users. Be aware of others around you.
- If you have any injuries, they must be reported to a member of staff.
- If you have any pre-existing medical conditions or are pregnant, please consult your doctor prior to engaging in any of the Clubs activities.
- The outside ramps can potentially become dangerous to use in the event of wet or slippery conditions. Whilst staff will advise and will close the outside plaza when necessary, they may not always be aware of changing weather conditions so you must exercise extreme care and seek staff advice if required.
- Under 10s must always be accompanied by an adult apart from during coached sessions or when advised otherwise by staff.
- No food or drink in the skatepark.
- All users must be treated with respect and courtesy. We are an inclusive community.
- We reserve the right to ask anyone to leave if their behaviour compromises the safety and/or enjoyment of others, no refunds will be offered.
- We have a zero-tolerance policy to drink and drugs on the premises, including outside.
- The above rules are displayed throughout the park, on our website and are available from staff on request. By completing a disclaimer form you are agreeing to abide by all the rules and understand that you are using the park entirely at your own risk.
